Parklets instead of parkingspaces

„Grätzloasen“ (Quarter oasis)

- Furniture for streets
- Maximum extension: 10 m or 2 parking spaces
- Assumption of liability by "license holder"
- No commercial use
- Use directly in front of the enterprises
- Support by letting the road surface free of charge
- professional advice and a maximum of 4000 €

Spielstraße (Play streets)

Additional leeway

To promote the revival of a “street game culture” in the immediate vicinity

Show children (and adults) that the appropriation of streets is possible and desirable

Topics: Quality of public space, traffic calming, climate change adaptation.


Process: Top-down approach with citizen participation and Tactical Urbanism methods, recently bottom-up initiatives.

Concrete development concepts of the municipality with the aim of increasing the quality of living and public spaces in the district


Current development: First implemented pilot project in 2022. High interest of districts in other neighbourhoods. Categorisation of the street network planned.


Why Tactical Urbanism in Vienna?
